any other year in the history of our great financial institution. There was much BERT ARES for which to be frustrated and confused. There was much for which to be fearful. And vet, Land of Lincoln Credit Union continued its journey of unparalleled financial performance and unaltered commitment to service. We are very proud of both.

Your credit union experienced organic growth unlike any other year in its history. As of December 31, 2020, assets totaled \$307MM compared to \$259MM at December 31, 2019. This represents growth approximately 18.5%. By contrast, at September 30, 2020, credit unions in our NCUA peer-group experienced growth of 17.6%.

Your credit union, also, experienced growth in membership and shares. At December 31, 2019, membership totaled 32,312. As of December 31, 2020, membership had expanded to 32,455 members. Shares at December 31, 2019 totaled \$227MM versus \$271MM at December 31, 2020, or 19.6%

2020 was unlike increase. LLCU continued to enhanced security measures provide loans to its members. Through the end of the 2020, your credit union made more than 5,400 loans totaling \$73MM. Many of the loans made to our members would not have otherwise been made available to them by other financial institutions. Moreover, the delinquency ratio, 0.50%, was maintained well below that of peer.

**A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT** 

Your credit union, in 2020, increased dividends paid to it members by 6.5%. Even so, your credit union continued to be very profitable. The return on assets, a metric used to determine the profitability of an organization, was 0.91%. By comparison, as of September 30, 2020, that metric for our national peer credit unions was 0.50%. Finally, our capital ratio, a very healthy 11.17%, positions our credit union for continued, sustainable, growth.

As part of providing new products and services, we rolled out our new online banking platform. The old platform had not been updated for several years and our members were, on an ongoing basis, experiencing prolonged service outages. This new platform allows for and features such as password self-reset, touch ID and face ID capabilities, drag and drop funds transfers and more. Also, late in 2019, LLCU developed and began offering in-house 15-year and 30-year residential mortgages to our members. This product was well received. In 2020, LLCU provided 251 members in-house 1st mortgages totaling more than \$31MM, and an additional 121 members received mortgage financing through a preferred 3rd party provider.

Land of Lincoln Credit Union committed to the continued development of our staff. 33 of our teammates completed courseworktobecomeCertified Financial Counselors. These individuals, now, stand ready to better assist our members in achieving financial success.

Community involvement and enrichment remained a priority at LLCU. In spite of the ongoing and everchanging restrictions due to COVID 19, the staff provided more than 1,100 hours of volunteer service to more than 150 different religious and civic organizations in the various markets that we serve. of our members experienced interruptions in employment due to COVID 19, LLCU provided those that were impacted with payment deferments. Likewise, your credit union made monetary donations exceeding \$135,000 in support of local non-profit organizations. Of that, local food banks received more than \$20,000 in donations. That was equivalent to serving just under 10,000 meals. The staff assisted more than 300 members to improve their credit through the use of our fresh start
