How does Land of Lincoln Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Land of Lincoln Credit Union collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: Open an account or apply for a loan Make deposits or withdrawals from your account
	We also collect your information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<ul> <li>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</li> <li>sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes- information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul>
	State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul> <li>Land of Lincoln Credit Union has no affiliates.</li> </ul>
Nonaffiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>Nonaffiliates we share with can include insurance companies.</li> </ul>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.  Land of Lincoln Credit Union doesn't jointly market.
